Gift yourself Little Ragghi's Crackers

Gift alert: Next time you need to find a small token for your host or hostess, consider Little Ragghi's Crackers.

The savory crisps are ideal in their simplicity. Creator Raggatha Rain Calentine, the snack's namesake, rolls out flatbreads before sending them to the oven to crisp up. For flavor, the bare minimum of high-quality olive oil and Parmesan cheese replaces the heavy-handed spice mixtures of other crackers and chips.

Although these crackers need no accompaniment (besides perhaps a glass of wine), their focused flavor makes them fit right in on a cheese plate or crumbled over salads in place of croutons. And we'll wager they'll become a regular sidekick to our favorite soups, too.
